




## NDRRMC UPDATE

**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 125 KM North of Virac, Catanduanes (**14.7°N, 124.1°E**). Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.
