**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Egay" was estimated based on all available data including Baler Doppler Radar at 380 km East of Baler, Aurora (15.7N, 125.1E) with maximum winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 10kph.
