PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Egay" was estimated based on Aparri Doppler Radar and all available data at 135 km Southwest of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (17.8N, 119.4E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph. It is forecast to move north at 7 kph.
