PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "KARDING" (YAGI) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 990 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (24.2 °N, 130.7 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 75 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 90 KM/HR. MOVING NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bataan – particularly Balanga and Moron. • Zambales – particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul and Lawis. • Bulacan – all rivers and tributaries. • Aurora – particularly Casiguran, Aguang, and Lower Umiray. • Nueva Ecija – all rivers and tributaries.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are **advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.**
