PRESENT WEATHER:

Monsoon rains which may trigger flashfloods and landslides will be experienced over Ilocos Region. Occasional rains are expected over the regions of Cordillera and Cagayan Valley and the provinces of Zambales and Bataan. Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated thunderstorms will prevail over Metro Manila and the rest of the country.
