



PRESENT WEATHER:

Easterlies affecting the eastern section of the country.

No. 03 (FINAL) for Region II (CAGAYAN VALLEY)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ISABELA particularly Dikatayan, Dinilican, and Palanan-Pinacanauan.• CAGAYAN particularly Linao, Lower Abulug, Lower Pamplona, Cabicungan, Aunugay, Baua, Palawaig, and Taboan.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:
