PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 330 KM South Southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (7.9°N, 117.7°E). Tail-end of a cold front affecting the eastern section of Northern and Central Luzon.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rainshowers and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: CAGAYAN particularly Linao, Lower Abulug, Lower Pamplona, Cabicungan, Aunugay, Baua, Palawaig, and Taboan
	• ISABELA particularly Dikatayan, Dinilican, and Palanan- Pinacanauan

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are advised to take the necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
