PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the low pressure area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 375 KM West of Iba, Zambales (15.2°N, 116.5°E)

Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay-Catabangan.• RIZAL particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa.• LAGUNA particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Santa Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal.

Concerned Regional and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (R/LDRRMCs) are still advised to take necessary preparedness measures and possible response actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
