PRESENT WEATHER:

At **4:00 PM** today, the eye of Tropical Storm “Chedeng” was estimated based on all available data at **340 km Southeast of Casiguran, Aurora (14.8°N, 124.9°E)**, with maximum sustained winds of **115 kph** near the center and gustiness of up to **145 kph**. It is forecast to move **West Northwest** at **20 kph**.
