**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **4:00 PM** today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) (formerly "BISING") was estimated based on all available data at **690 km east of Juban, Sorsogon (13.3°N, 130°E)**. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
