#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "GENER" was located based on all available data at 1,035 KM East of Casiguran, Aurora (16.1°N, 131.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 160 kph. It is forecast to move northwest at 25 kph.
