**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 10:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "LANDO" was estimated based on all available data at 1055 km East of Baler, Aurora (15.4°N, 131.4°E). Maximum sustained winds of 75 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 90 kph. It is forecast to move West at 17 kph.
