PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. Meanwhile, at 4:00 AM, the eye of Typhoon Hanna was located based on all available data at 955 KM east of Basco, Batanes (20.3N, 131.1E) with maximum sustained winds of 175 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 210 KPH. It is forecasted to move west northwest at 20 KPH.
