Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains with isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and its Tributaries in:</u> BATANGAS particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Karumpong, Rosario-Lobo, Upper Bolbok and Lawaya. CAVITE particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Canas, Ilang-Ilang and Imus LAGUNA particularly Sta Maria, Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal QUEZON particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta Lucia, Lugan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal, Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island), Upper Kibay and Catabangan.
