### PRESENT WEATHER:

Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon. Easterlies affecting the eastern section of Visayas and Mindanao.

**FORECAST RAINFALL:** Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms.

### WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- **Tagum-Libuganon River** and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Simong Rivers.

### PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions evacuation rather than rescue.
