PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the low pressure area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 205 KM West Southwest of General Santos City, South Cotabato (5.4 N, 123.5 E). Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.

FORECAST RAINFALL:

Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers.

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED:

- **TAGUM-LIBUGANON RIVER** and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Lasang Rivers.

With this event and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.

ACTIONS TAKEN:
