**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 PM** today, Tropical Depression "Agaton" was estimated based on all available data at 200 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (**9.0N, 128.0E**) with maximum winds of **45 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to 60 km/h. It is forecast to move west at 19 km/h. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.

**FORECAST RAINFALL:** Occasional rains with gusty winds.

**WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:**

- Tagum-Libuganon River and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Simong Rivers.

**PUBLIC WARNINGS:**

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
