PRESENT WEATHER

At 3:00 AM today, Tropical Depression "AGATON" was estimated based on all available data at 60 km South of Maasin, Southern Leyte (9.6N, 124.9E) with maximum winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 90 km/h. It is forecast to move west at 25 km/h Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
