**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon “KONG-REY” was located based on all available data at 1,250 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (17.4°N, 133.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of 190 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 235 km/h. It is moving northwest at 15km/h.
