At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "BUTCHOY" was located based on all available data at 615 km East of Basco, Batanes (19.8°N, 127.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 210 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 245 KPH. It is forecast to move northwest at 30 KPH. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas.
