PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon “RUBY” was located based on all available data at the vicinity of Calbayog City or at 40 KM Northwest of Catbalogan, Samar (12.0°N, 124.6°E), with maximum sustained winds of 160 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 195 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 15 kph.
