### PRESENT WEATHER:

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At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "BUTCHOY" was located based on all available data at 330 km East of Basco, Batanes (20.9°N, 125.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 220 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 255 KPH. It is forecast to move northwest at 25 KPH. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas.
