PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 4:00 AM TODAY, A LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 295 KM EAST OF MINDANAO (08.5°N, 129.0°E). IT IS EMBEDDED ALONG THE INTERTROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ) ACROSS VISAYAS.
