AT 4:00 PM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABALE DATA AT 170 KM NORTHEAST OF VIRAC, CATANDUANES (15.0°N, 125.0°E). IT IS EMBEDDED ALONG THE INTERTROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ) ACROSS VISAYAS. CLOUDY SKIES WITH LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINS AND THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE EXPERIENCED OVER MIMAROPA, BICOL REGION, WESTERN VISAYAS, and EASTERN VISAYAS.
