PRESENT WEATHER:

SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON CIMARON WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 2,300 KM EAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (21.2 °N, 144.1 °E)[OUTSIDE PAR] WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 120 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 145 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H. TYPHOON SOULIK LOCATION OF THE EYE (3PM): 1,270 KM NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (28.4 °N, 131.0 °E)[OUTSIDE PAR] MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS: 160 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER GUSTINESS: 195 KM/H MOVEMENT: NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H.
