AT 3:00 AM TODAY, A LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 270 KM WEST OF SINAIT, ILOCOS SUR (18.0 °N, 117.9 °E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON. SEVERE TROPICAL STORM AMPIL (FORMERLY "INDAY") at 03:00 AM IS LOCATED AT 905 KM NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (25.4 °N, 129.0 °E) (OUTSIDE PAR) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 90 KPH GUSTINESS UP TO 115 KPH AND MOVEMENT OF NORTHWEST AT 25 KPH.
