### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm "JENNY" was estimated based on all available data at 1,280 km East of Calayan, Cagayan (19.5°, 133.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 07 kph. Southwest Monsoon affecting Visayas and Mindanao.
