#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 170 km Northeast of Daet, Camarines Norte (14.7° N, 124.4° E) embeded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Bicol Region and the eastern sections of Visayas and Mindanao.
