### PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "INDAY" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 995 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (22.5°N, 131.3°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 85 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 105 KM/H. MOVING NORTHWEST AT 15 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.

**No. 8 for CAR (Cordillera Administrative Region)**

<b>FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL</b>	<b>Light to moderate with occasional heavy rains</b>
<b>WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<u><b>Rivers and Tributaries in:</b></u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Abra</b> particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, Ikmin.</li> <li>• <b>Ifugao</b> – all rivers and its tributaries.</li> <li>• <b>Apayao</b> particularly Upper Abulug.</li> <li>• <b>Mountain Province</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li> <li>• <b>Kalinga</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li> <li>• <b>Benguet</b> particularly Upper Bauang</li> </ul>
