PRESENT WEATHER:

At 2:00 PM today, Tropical Depression "URDUJA" was estimated based on all available data at 480 km east northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (9.2N, 130.6E) with maximum winds of 55 km/h and gustiness of up to 65 km/h. It is forecast to move North Northwest at 6 km/h. Tail-end of a cold front affecting the Eastern section of Central and Southern Luzon.

FORECAST RAINFALL:

Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- Tagum-Libuganon River and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Lasang rivers.


PUBLIC WARNING:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions evacuation rather than rescue.
