AT 3:00 PM TODAY, TROPICAL DEPRESSION "BASYANG" WAS IN THE VICINITY OF GARCIA HERNANDEZ, BOHOL (9.7N, 124.3E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80KM/H. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE WEST NORTHWEST AT 27KM/HR. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.
