PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "GORIO" (NESAT) was located based on all available data at 555 km North Northwest of Basco, Batanes (25.1°N 120.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 140 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 190 km/h. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 15 km/h meanwhile, Tropical Storm with International name (Haitang) was estimated at 385 km West Southwest of Basco, Batanes (19.7°N 118.4°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80km/h. It is forecast to move Northeast at 22km/h. Southwest monsoon affecting the Western Section of Northern and Central Luzon.
