AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (MM) AS OF 4:00 AM TODAY:

Past **24-hrs** observed rainfall: 40 millimeters

Forecast **24- hr** rainfall: 10 to 20 millimeters

AREAS OF CONCERN (WATERWAYS AND AREAS LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED)

- Pasac-Guagua Allied River Basin (Pampanga Province); Porac- Gumain and Pasig-Portero Rivers; Affected Municipalities; Guagua, Sasmuan, Lubao, Bacolor, Sta. Rita, Minalin, Sto. Tomas and FloridaBlanca
- Lower Main Pampanga River Basin; Affected Municipalities: Candaba, San Luis, San Simon, Apalit, Calumpit, Hagonoy, Macabebe and Masantol (particular areas in the Pampanga Delta- portions of Pampanga and Bulacan Provinces)
- Ponding of rainwater at relatively Low-Lying Areas

AWARENESS INFORMATION/ADVISORY:

Main Pampanga River is still below alert level the Southwest monsoon (Habagat) enhanced by the Tropical Storm "INDAY" will bring occasional rains over the basin today..

Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) along the abovementioned areas of concern are still advised to take precautionary measures to mitigate potential adverse impacts of accumulation of rainwater combined with high tide at relatively low-lying areas and areas (and coastal areas) and areas with poor drainage system.


PUBLIC WARNING:
