AT 3:00 PM TODAY 29 JULY 2020, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 35 KM NORTH NORTHWEST OF DAET, CAMARINES NORTE (14.4 °N, 122.8 °E). SOUTHWESST MONSOON AFFECTING SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO.
