PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of TY "OMPONG" was located based on all available data at **665 KM East of Infanta, Quezon (15.3°N, 127.8°E)** maximum sustained winds of 205 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 255 KM/H. It is moving West Northwest at **20 KM/H**. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

No. 02 for CAR (Cordillera Administrative Region)
