PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 AM** today, the center of Severe Tropical Storm "GORIO" (NESAT) was estimated based on all available data at **545 km East Northeast of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan** or **460 km East of Basco, Batanes (19.9°N 126.3°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **105 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **130 km/h**. It is forecast to move Northwest at **15 km/h**. Southwest Monsoon affecting Luzon and Western Visayas.
