**PRESENT WEATHER:**

SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON SOULIK WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,780 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (25.1°N, 138.6°E) [OUTSIDE PAR] WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 160 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 195 KM/H. MOVING WEST SLOWLY.
