PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "SALOME" (HAIKUI) was estimated based on all available data at 190 KM West Northwest of Iba, Zambales (15.9°N, 118.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 75 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 90 km/h. It is forecasted to move Northwest at 20 KM/H.
