**PRESENT WEATHER:**

AT 3:00 **AM** TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM “KARDING” (YAGI) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **1,265 KM** EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (**20.6 °N, 134.1 °E**) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/HR. **MOVING NORTH NORTHEAST** AT 15 KM/HR. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.

**No. 5 (Final) for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)**

**No. 2 for CAR (Cordillera Administrative Region)**

<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Benguet</b> particularly Upper Bauang</li><li>• <b>Ifugao</b> – all rivers and its tributaries.</li><li>• <b>Apayao</b> particularly Upper Abulug.</li><li>• <b>Abra</b> particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, Ikmin.</li><li>• <b>Mountain Province</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li><li>• <b>Kalinga</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li></ul>
