PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon affecting the western sections of Luzon and Visayas. Meanwhile, at 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "SOULIK" was located based on all available data at 1,915 KM east of Northeast of extreme Northern Luzon (24.8 °N, 140.0 °E) [OUTSIDE PAR] with maximum sustained winds of 140 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 170km/h. It is almost stationary.

PALAWAN – particularly Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-Baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlugan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron.
