**PRESENT WEATHER:**

**AT 3:00 PM TODAY, TROPICAL DEPRESSION "LUIS" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 350 KM NORTH NORTHWEST OF BASCO, BATANES (23.5 °N, 121.1 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 90 KM/H. IT IS MOVING EAST NORTHEAST AT 15 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTIONS OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON. TYPHOON CIMARON STS SOULIK LOCATION OF THE EYE (3PM): 1,805 KM NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (32.3 °N, 134.4°E) [OUTSIDE PAR] LOCATION (3PM): 1,505 KM NORTH NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (33.6 °N, 125.5 °E) [OUTSIDE PAR] MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS: 150 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS: 105 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER GUSTINESS: 185 KM/H GUSTINESS: 130 KM/H MOVEMENT: NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H.
