WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• EASTERN SAMAR particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat.• LEYTE particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan.• NORTHERN SAMAR particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay• SOUTHERN LEYTE particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan• SAMAR particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan• BILIRAN all rivers and its tributaries
