PRESENT WEATHER:

AT **3:00 AM** TODAY, TROPICAL DEPRESSION “LUIS” WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **430 KM** NORTH NORTHWEST OF BASCO, BATANES (**24.2 °N, 120.9 °E**) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF **40 KM/H** NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO **70 KM/H**. IT IS MOVING NORTHEAST AT **1 KM/H**. MEANWHILE, THE **LOW PRESSURE AREA** WAS ESTIMATED AT **1,205 KM** EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (**21.5 °N, 133.5°E**). **SOUTHWEST MONSOON** AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.
