#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 AM** today, the center of Tropical Storm "URDUJA" (KAI-TAK) was estimated based on all available data at **190 km East Northeast** of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (**12.0°N, 127.1°E**) with maximum winds of **80 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **95 km/h**. It is forecast to move West at **10 km/h**.
