**AT 03:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON "PAENG" WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,315 KM EAST OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN (17.3°N, 134.1°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 125 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 155 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST AT 20 KM/H.**
