



**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "SALOME" (HAIKU) was estimated based on all available data at 60 km Southwest of Subic, Zambales (14.4°N, 120.0°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 100 km/h. It is forecasted to move West Northwest at 20 KPH.
