**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **4:00 PM** today, the center of Tropical Depression "Odette" was estimated based on all available data at **285 KM East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.2N, 124.3E)** with maximum winds of **55 KM/H** near the center and gustiness of up to **65 KM/H**. It is forecast to move west at **30 KM/H**.
