PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM “KARDING” (YAGI) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **1,160 KM** EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (**20.9 °N, 133.1 °E**) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/HR. **MOVING WEST** AT **10 KM/HR**. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.
