At 3:00 PM today, the eye of TY "OMPONG" was located based on all available data at 625 KM East Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes (14.8°N, 129.9°E) maximum sustained winds of 205 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 255 KM/H. It is moving West Northwest at 25 KM/H. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
