**No. 02 for Region XIII (CARAGA)**

<b>WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>AGUSAN DEL SUR</b> - particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.</li><li>• <b>SURIGAO DEL NORTE</b> - particularly Surigao and Magallanes.</li><li>• <b>DINAGAT ISLANDS</b> - particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet.</li><li>• <b>AGUSAN DEL NORTE</b> - particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.</li><li>• <b>SURIGAO DEL SUR</b> - particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.</li></ul>

**ACTION/S TAKEN:**

NDRRMC Advisory on General Flood Advisory was disseminated to **OCD Regional Offices II, IV-A, V, and CARAGA** through facsimile, SMS, and website for further dissemination to respective LDRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are still advised to be alerted for possible flashfloods and landslides.
